The Core Problem

We are living in an engineered outrage spiral.

- Politics has become a stimulus-response system
- Society is fragmented and emotionally hijacked into social media bubbles
- Technology is reinforcing division instead of repairing it
- Human agency is eroding in favor of algorithmic exploitation



Why Now?

Advanced Cognitive Computing AI agents are coming—fast.

- They will either pacify us with passive consumption and helplessness
- Or guide us toward contribution, empathy, and health
- The infrastructure is already here: mass surveillance, behavioral data, and national security computing power

What Is Project LANTERN?

Project LANTERN is a national redirection initiative.

It uses cognitive computing and behavioral modeling to quietly guide individuals and systems toward stability, dignity, and purpose—without coercion or centralized control.

Key Functions:

• Digital Nudging Infrastructure

Identifies vulnerable, at-risk, or destabilized individuals and softly intervenes with context-specific nudges—delivered through everyday digital platforms—to redirect behavior before it becomes harmful.

• Interpreter Layer for Trust & Oversight

Translates cognitive agent decisions into transparent, explainable language for human oversight (policymakers, ethicists, affected populations).

• Behavioral Targeting for Stability

Uses anonymized behavioral data to model emotional trajectories, social friction, and risk signals—then deploys scalable, context-appropriate interventions (content, suggestions, agent support).

• Alignment with Public Good. Optimizes for human well-being and the betterment of the United States.

Example Use Cases:

- Detecting early signs of violent extremism or social collapse on social media, and gently intervening
- → Rehabilitating individuals via intelligent, agent-driven therapy and reentry support
- → Guiding vulnerable populations toward jobs, education, or purpose
- → Helping communities resolve disputes, not amplify them

Components:

- **Cognitive Computing Backbone:** A national infrastructure connecting public institutions (labs, universities, agencies) and private AI companies to coordinate resources, data, and direction for safe, public-good focused cognitive computing.
- Universal Model Sharing Protocol: A standardized framework for Al systems to share insights and models in real-time, accelerating breakthroughs and ensuring transparency.
- Interpreter Layer: An AI system that translates complex outputs from cognitive systems into understandable language for humans, fostering trust and understanding.
- **Behavioral Simulation Network:** A secure platform for running large-scale simulations to test the impact of policies and technologies before implementation, reducing societal risk.

Policy Hooks:

• **EPIC** (Expanding Partnerships for Innovation and Competitiveness) We need cross-sector innovation in AI and cognitive computing.

• National AI Initiative Act

Authorizes federal AI research, coordination, and ethical development—can integrate Project LANTERN into existing government AI infrastructure.

• NIH & HHS Programs

Potential anchors for cognitive health pilots (e.g., agent-guided therapy, behavioral rehabilitation, life extension R&D).

DoD / DARPA Funding

Established funding channels for cognitive infrastructure, interpreter systems, and resilience simulation—especially under national security framing.

Executive Order Alignment

LANTERN aligns with existing White House AI safety and innovation priorities—could be launched by directive or advisory task force.

Call to Action

Form a federal task force with:

- AI leaders, behavioral scientists, national security officials, and ethicists
- Build prototype use cases in key regions (health, justice, reintegration)
- Provide tax and patent incentives for companies that contribute models
- Launch Project LANTERN as a strategic deterrent to societal collapse
